

Frequently asked questions about the Pudding Club

Do I have to be a member?

No, but you will need to book in advance.

When are the meetings?

There is a meeting every Friday night and sometimes there are extra meetings, including Saturdays. Please ask for an up to date list of meetings or see www.threewayshousehotel.com

How much does it cost and what does it include?

From 1st December 2010, places at Pudding Club meetings will be £36 each and include a welcome drink, a light main course, a buffet of seven traditional puddings, rules, history and lots of fun!

Are there always steamed and baked puddings?

In June, July and August the Summer Pudding Club meetings feature three hot puddings and four cold ones like Gooseberry Fool and Summer Pudding itself.

Can I stay overnight?

Many people make the most of the evening and stay overnight - or for the weekend. You can even stay in a unique Pudding Bedroom.

What should I wear?

Most guests wear smart casual clothing.

How many people attend each meeting?

They are very popular and attract up to seventy guests. Everyone sits at large tables to make this a fun and informal evening.

These fun evenings start at 7.30pm with a refreshing glass of Elderflower Pressé in the lounge and an introduction to the rules and history of the club. After a choice of three modest main courses the main business of the evening begins when seven traditional puddings are paraded with ceremony - and cheers of anticipation. Puddings include well known favourites like Sticky Toffee Pudding as well as the more unusual such as Sussex Pond and Lord Randall's Pudding. Each pudding is accompanied by lashings of Custard and you can indulge in as many as you want, within the rules, until you say "Enough!" Afterwards relax with coffee and tea while casting your vote for "Pudding of the Night". Meetings are great fun and very popular. Places can be reserved at £36 per guest and a non-refundable deposit of £20 per guest will secure your place and ensure a memorable evening. For parties of 8 or more pre-payment will be required 8 weeks beforehand.
